Dorie Mack had foot surgery, but is doing well and is happy to report she'll be in regular shoes for the Ladies Dinner!

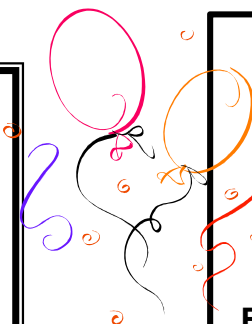


WYC'S AWARDS
